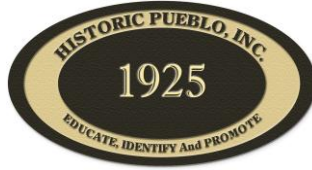


Order your Historic Resource Plaque today!

- The cost of the plaque includes a membership in Historic Pueblo, Inc. and furthers the work of HPI in protecting and enhancing historic structures. Requires only a simple one-page application, documenting the age of your house and describing the historic significance you know of.
- No regulations from the Historic Preservation Commission limiting alterations to the building.

The Pueblo Registry of Historic Resources is an archival record of historic resources maintained by Historic Pueblo Inc a private non-profit corporation working in partnership with Pueblo's Historic Preservation Commission. The registry recognizes the architectural integrity and beauty of Pueblo's historic houses and commercial buildings, while allowing them to adapt to the needs of families and evolving lifestyles in the 21st Century.

What is the Pueblo Historic Resource Registry?

- An archival record established by the nonprofit Historic Pueblo Inc. in partnership with the Pueblo Historic Preservation Commission to preserve the architectural integrity and beauty of pueblo's historic homes and buildings and to adapt them to the needs of families evolving lifestyles in the 21st Century.

- A portion of the cost of the plaque will further the work of HPI in protecting and enhancing historic structures. Membership in HPI for one year is included in the cost.
- No regulations from the Historic Preservation Commission limiting alterations to the house.
- HPI will review the application and recommend registration to the Historic Preservation Commission at their annual review of the Registry. Plaques awarded at an HPI Historic Resource Registration Ceremony.
